**Communion -** The boys and girls in 3rd Class made their Communion on Saturday, 16th October in a beautiful ceremony.





Drama - All classes have enjoyed drama with Tara, one of our SNA's this term. Each class put together a Christmas digital performance which has been sent to parents on Seesaw.


